Thank you for all your bids on Auction #25, and once again, making it a success.

BIDDING RULES:

You may place a single bid (will not automatically be reduced) or you may use the Reserve Bid System. You may place up to 3 bids per roll. The winning bid will be the average between the next high bid, over \$5.00, and the reserve bid. (Example = \$3.50 - \$5.00 - \$10.00. The next high bid is \$8.00. The winning bid is \$9.00.) If the next high bid is under \$5.00, the reserve bid will be averaged with \$5.00. First bid will be treated as a single bid, and will not be automatically reduced.

Roll offered as **no min bid**, should be regarded as "Repair Rolls" and will usually require major repairs. On these rolls, I'll accept any bids, including reserve bids under \$3.00.
